

SAMPLE AGREEMENT

Beacon Hill Ranch

Thank you for your purchase of a Pembroke Welsh Corgi puppy. Corgis are very smart, sassy and loving dogs who are equally at home on the ranch or in your home. Good with children and adults alike, Corgis grow up to be beloved members of the family if given love, attention and training from the time they are young. Your puppy is registerable with the American Kennel Club, at your expense. Necessary information and application for registration is included with this contract.

It is very important that your puppy receive regular health check-ups, worming and vaccinations. Your puppy's first exam including having its tail docked and dewclaws removed was at 3-5 days of age. Your puppy received its first worming at ~4 weeks and then additional worming every 2 weeks thereafter. This should be continued every 2 weeks until 4 months of age. Your puppy received its first set of vaccinations at age 6 weeks. The next vaccinations should be given at 8-9 weeks of age and continued by your veterinarian's instructions thereafter.

Health Guarantee

Health: The seller certifies that this puppy is current on vaccinations and de-worming, and per veterinarian's exam is in good physical health. For this guarantee to be valid, it is the buyer's responsibility to take the puppy to a state licensed veterinarian within 7 days of purchase for an examination, at the buyer's expense. If the veterinarian finds the puppy in good health OR if the buyer fails to have an examination within 7 days, the seller will assume no further responsibility. Should the veterinarian find a health concern with the puppy, the buyer must notify the seller in writing within the 7 day period and provide a written diagnosis from the examining veterinarian. The buyer agrees to make the puppy available to the seller's veterinarian for a second opinion within 7 days of notification of a health concern. If the same health concern is detected by the seller's veterinarian, the buyer may exchange the puppy for a similar one, pending availability, or may receive a full refund of the purchase price (does not include shipping costs). Should the buyer decide to keep the puppy after health issue is fully discussed, all expense and responsibility will be the buyer's from that point forward. This guarantee does not cover death, illness or injury resulting from abuse or neglect on the part of the buyer.

Special Considerations: Seller will make every effort to honor requests for a certain color; personality etc however judgments made at 6-12 weeks on either are based on observable information at that time and may not guarantee adult color due to normally occurring color changes or behavioral changes which occur after the pup leaves the seller's hands.

Acceptance: The undersigned buyer hereby acknowledges having read the terms of the contract and does hereby agree to abide by each of the provisions set forth above.
